

Suggested Packing List & Camp Laundry Information

ILC is an active, casual camp. The information below contains details about ILC's climate, our laundry procedure, suggested packing list, and begins with what NOT to bring. It is intended to help you pack up your camper for their session at camp.

WHAT <u>NOT</u> TO BRING

While packing up your camper for their time at ILC please take the time to have a conversation with your camper about prohibited items. In the best interest of everyone's safety please check their belongings to ensure they do not bring any of the following to camp.

📩 ITEMS THAT ARE NOT ALLOWED

Campers are **NOT ALLOWED** to Bring:

ANY Cell Phone or electronic device that has access to wifi, cell service, or able to transfer data.

WEATHER INFORMATION

Campers tend to dress comfortably, prepared for a lot of physical activity and for a variety of temperatures and weather. ILC is located in the Pocono Mountains at 2,500 feet elevation. We have amazing summer weather and clean mountain air with limited humidity, beautiful sunny days and cool nights (perfect for sleeping). Keep in mind while you are packing that average summer daytime temperatures range from 70 to 90 degrees Fahrenheit and nighttime can range from 55 to 70 degrees Fahrenheit. It is good to be prepared for different temperature and weather changes throughout the day and session.

CAMP LAUNDRY SERVICE INFORMATION

Laundry at ILC is done once a week in commercial washers and dryers off the premises. The laundry process is as follows:

- > Each bunk collects and combines their campers' dirty laundry into 2 bags, separated by lights and darks
- > Our service picks up all of the bags on Sundays and returns clean laundry on Tuesdays.

SUGGESTED PACKING LIST

- Please provide approximately <u>10 days worth of clothing</u>. Do not bring delicate clothing.
- Label with the camper's name: all clothing, shoes, linens, equipment, electronics, instruments and cords etc.
- Please ensure all luggage and packed items are clean and dry. <u>Put all clothes in the dryer for 30 min prior to packing</u>. Inspect luggage before
 packing to ensure they are clean and do not have any critters, especially if they are stored in the garage or have been traveling to other places.
- Use this suggested packing check-off list as a guide. Adjustments should be made for your child's individual interests and needs:
